Privacy Policy for the use of Facebook plug-ins (Like-Button)

The pages of this blog sometimes use the plugins of the social network Facebook, provider Facebook Inc., 1 Hacker Way, Menlo Park, California 94025, USA. The Facebook plugins can be recognized by the Facebook logo or the "Like-Button" ("Like") on our site. When you visit the pages, the plugin establishes a direct connection between your browser and the Facebook server. Privacy Policy for the use of Google Analytics

This website uses functions of the web analytics service Google Analytics. Provider is the Google Inc. 1600 Amphitheater Parkway Mountain View, CA 94043, USA. Google Analytics uses so-called "cookies". These are text files that are stored on your computer and that allow an analysis of the use of the website by you.
